# Report – Archery NSW V.P. Publicity

- Thanks to those clubs who made themselves available with their members, in particular Armidale, Cessnock, Erina, Frog Hollow, Illawarra, Newcastle, Northern, Penrith and Warringah for media comments.
- Early on in my appointment ArcheryNSW enrolled me in a “Working with the Media course”, which I can recommend to all clubs to take part in. If there is a local one being run by your Local Council, take the time to attend. One case study was how netball came out from the female basketball shadows. In short, promoted regional and regional juniors, allocated most state competitions to regional centres where media coverage would be greater. Eventually Netball Australia was able to show major sponsors the regional media coverage gained, which highlighted the link between both organisations. This allowed them to then launch the ANZ netball competition. One of my roles is to encourage and work with our regional clubs in NSW to take a more active part in ArcheryNSW activities and events.
- I am also currently working on some major sponsorship deals with national companies. As we are in the very early stages of negotiations, it is not appropriate to divulge who as yet.
- ArcheryNSW was successful in obtaining more than 10 individual prime time TV news grabs regarding development days, individual results and tournaments from WIN Illawarra, WIN Armidale, NBN Newcastle and NBN Central Coast.
- Twice on local Central Coast community radio promoting Junior QRE at Erina Archery. Once promoting the State/National Indoor hosted by Erina Archery. Once on local AUS Star radio 2GO promoting the Central Coast Youth Centre and the State/National Indoor titles hosted by Erina Archery.
- More than 10 sets of tournament results were published in the Sydney Daily Telegraph.
- On four occasions, editorials were published in Archery Action magazine. Editorials are at no charge as long as ArcheryNSW pays to advertise tournaments.
- After I was contacted by Channel 7 producers, Penrith City Archers supplied archery equipment and instruction for the TV show “The Mole”.
- Contacted by a movie producer wanting to do research for movie and possibly require junior archers for doubles, still at early stages possibly late 2014.
- Steve Jennison and I brokered a sponsorship deal with Benson Archery. \$2000 for prize money for NSW state competition/titles to be split between them all at our discretion on how to use. Also \$2 each sale from an Archery NSW member to go to the NSW State Youth Development Squad, from 1<sup>st</sup> May 2013 until 27<sup>th</sup> August 2013 \$453.45 is available from Benson Archery. Clubs should encourage members to always have with them their Archery Australia registration card, as by showing this card they can gain a discount from Benson Archery and results in another \$2 donation to the NSW State Youth Development Squad.
- Local press which have run editorials on tournaments, development days or individual archers that I am aware of are: Newcastle Herald, Cessnock Advertiser, Central Coast Advocate, Manly Daily, Hornsby and Upper North Shore Advocate, Griffith Area News, Armidale Independent, Armidale Express and Penrith Star.

All in all a great year for Archery.
