



PRESIDENT DUTY STATEMENT

Adopted: Jun 2014

Ref – 2.1

1. There shall be one President.
2. The President is the most senior office-bearer of the Society and as such is responsible for being the public face, the tone, style, and well-being of the Society.
3. The President shall hold office for a two-year period which commenced in 1996, and must be a member of the Society.
4. The President shall be a member, ex-officio, of all regular and special committees.
5. The President must accept the responsibilities of leadership and ensure that the Society operates efficiently.
6. The President will preside at all Committee of Management & General Meetings of the Society in the capacity of Chairperson.
7. The President shall be responsible for co-ordinating:-
 - Policy & Procedures Manual of the Society
 - Roles & Responsibilities of office bearersand submit these to the Committee of Management for review annually or earlier as required.
8. The President shall present a President's report at the Annual General Meeting.
9. The President cannot hold any of the following positions (Secretary / Treasurer / Recorder / Coaching Administrator) while in this role.
